Academic Schedules:

Mr. Eason's courses: (week of 11/25) Senior High Bible students will examine II Samuel 13. We will discuss the concepts of friendship and dating. Junior High Bible students will continue studying lesson 12: Loving All People. Students will not have a Bible verse test this week. Senior High History students will continue their study of Chapter 5: Western Europe. Junior High History students will continue their study of chapter 7: Rome Before Christ. We will examine the fall of the Roman empire. PE We will not have P.E. this week due to Thanksgiving break. (week of 12/2) Senior High Bible students will examine Ch. 24: David and Absalom and Ch. 25: Absalom's Rebellion and David's Flight. We will have a quiz over the sections discussed. Junior High Bible students will begin lesson 13: Dealing with the flesh. All Bible students will study the verses, Luke 2:21-30. Students will have their Bible verse test on Friday. Senior High History students will complete their study of Chapter 5: Western Europe. This

week we will have an exam over this section. **Junior High History students** will continue their study of chapter 7: Rome Before Christ. We will finish the section of Rome and have an exam over chapters 6-7. **PE** students will continue exploring the fundamentals of basketball.

Mrs. Hess's courses: English Literature/Grammar students are studying "The Age of the Puritans" in literature. A major focus will be the works by John Milton. In grammar, our next test will cover sections 11-14. World Literature/Grammar students are continuing Unit 5, "Aspirations: Theme" in literature. In grammar, a major review test is scheduled. Jr. High English students will focus on the principal parts and tenses of *verbs*. Quizzes should be anticipated regularly as we complete our study. Jr. High Reading/Enrichment students continue reading from the textbook *Voyage of Discovery*. Both a comprehension quiz and reading quiz will continue to be administered. The quizzes are not timed but accurately reflect reading comprehension skills. These exercises will encourage student improvement throughout the course.

Mr. Huddleston's course: Keyboarding and Document Processing students will practice keying special characters and numbers. After the break, students will begin working on typing announcements and advertisements. Speed drills will continue throughout the week.

Mrs. Middlebrooke's courses: Jr. High Science students will learn about astronomy. They will have quizzes over sections 4.5-4.6 and 4.7-4.9. Biology students will study the circulatory system. They will have quizzes over sections 10.1 and 10.2-10.4. Anatomy students will continue to study the nervous system. They will have a quiz over pages 235-243 and will dissect a sheep brain.

Mr. Smith's courses: Junior High Math students will learn about circles and the math involved. We will be reviewing chapter 4 preparing for a test. There will be a quiz over section 4.4, section 4.5, and test over chapter 4. Students need a protractor and a compass. Algebra I students will simplify expressions, find rate of change and slope, and solve percent problems. There will be a quiz over sections 36-38 and a test over sections 31-35. Geometry students will continue to prove congruent triangles, prove inequalities, and using indirect proofs. There will be a quiz over material taught. Spanish II students will continue learning how to use past tense verbs. There will be a vocabulary quiz and a verse quiz. Health students will discuss how to recognize mental disorders. There will be a quiz over section 3.1.
